What actually is worship? What does it look and feel like? What's the connection between worship and serving? This workshop will help you get to the heart of worship.

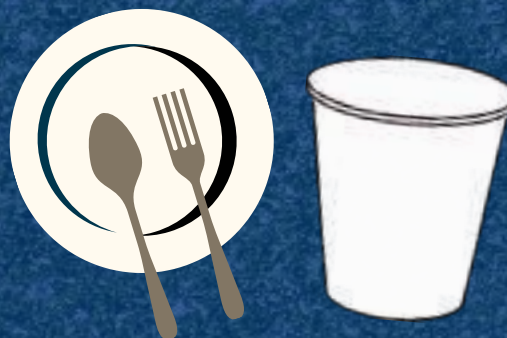

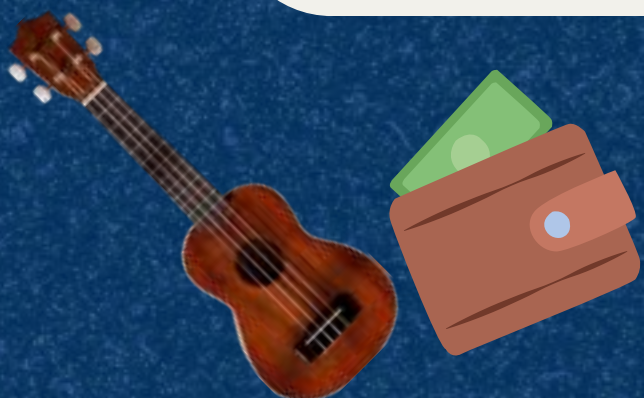

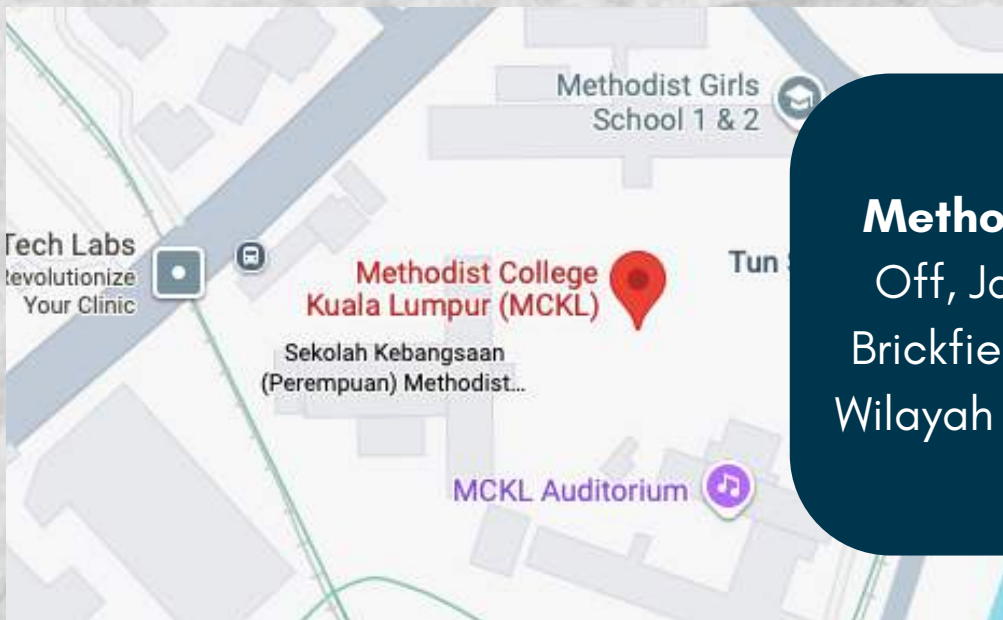
Camp Closing

As camp dismissal is right after Camp Closing, you may bring your child home afterwards.

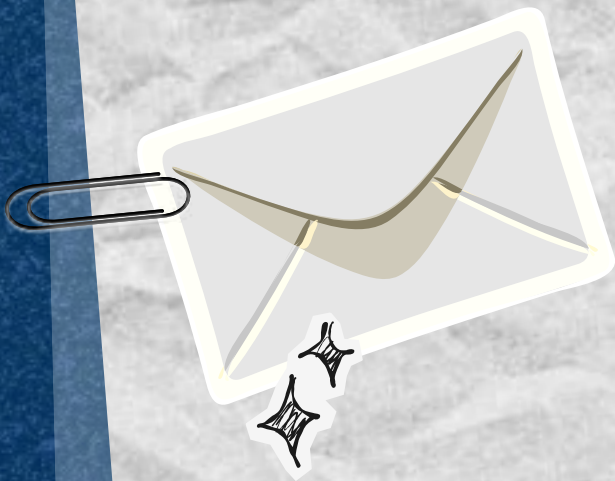
